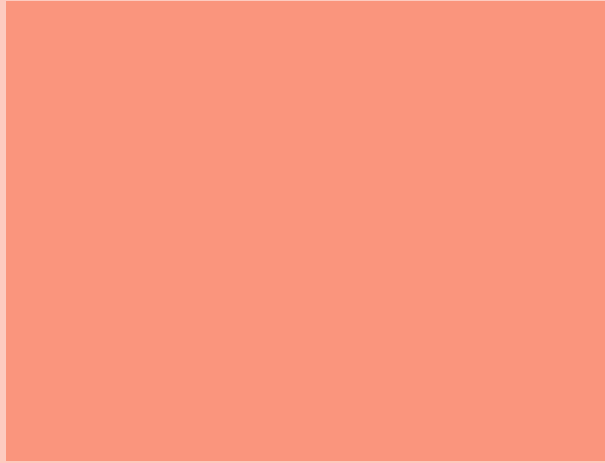

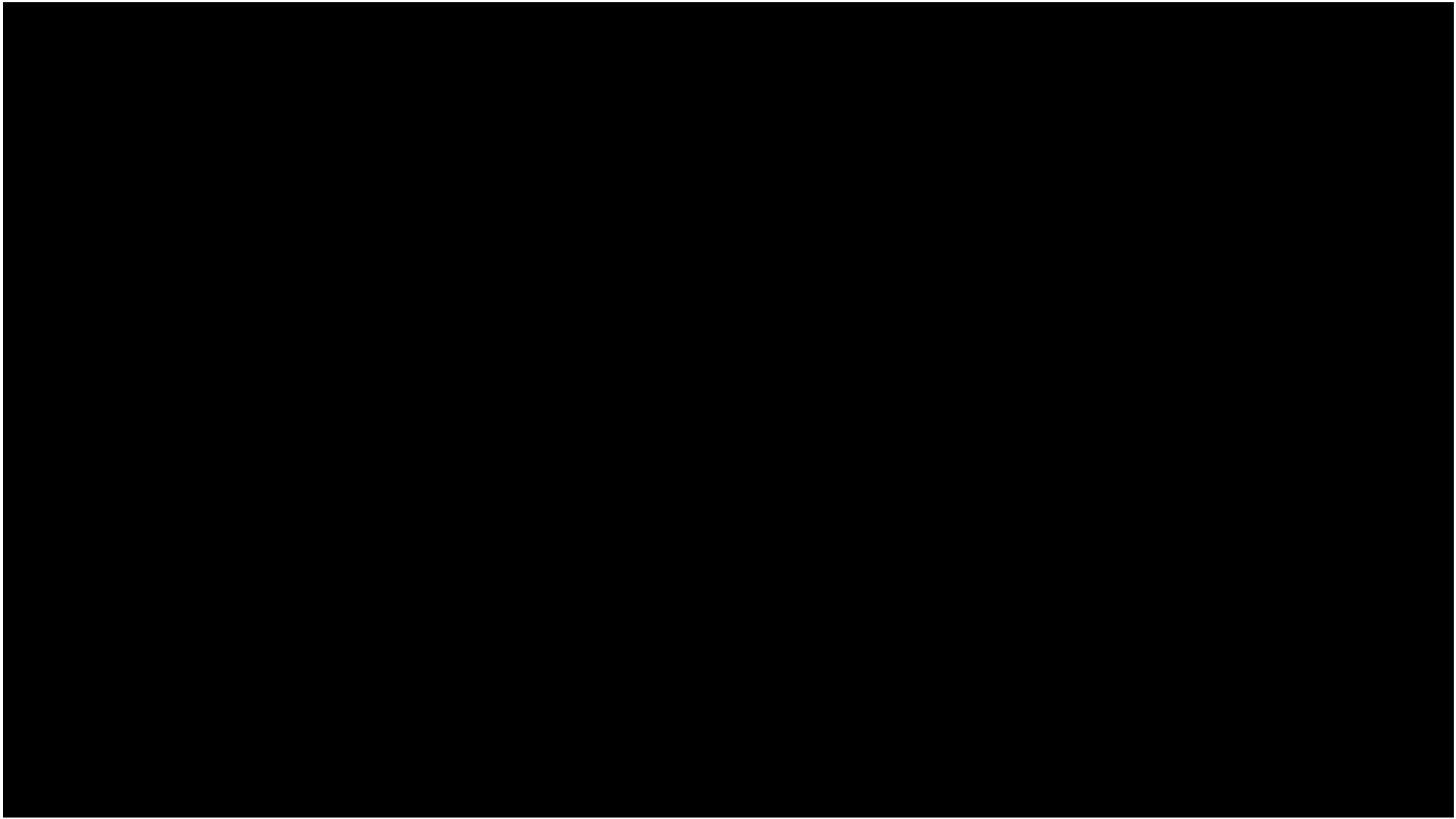

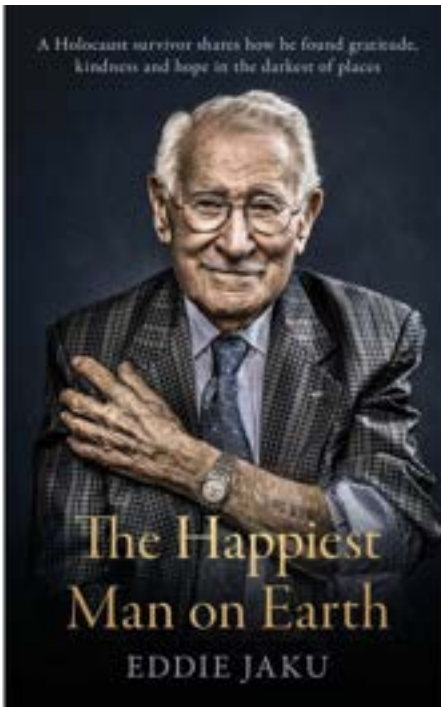

BJE and Y2i believes in the intrinsic value of students traveling to Israel during this formative stage of their life

The cost of NESIAH in 2024 will be **approximately \$16,000** - Y2i discretionary subsidy of up to \$4000 = **\$12,000**)

(Further means tested financial assistance is available)*

This includes the full cost of airfares, accommodation, insurance, ground transport, security, food and tours, an Israeli simcard and laundry once a week.

WHAT IF WE REQUIRE FURTHER FINACIAL ASSISTANCE?*

YEAR 11 families who have previously completed a Y2i subsidy application form in 2023, are not required to complete a subsidy form again.

For those that are new to the program in 2024, please email info@y2i.com.au to discuss your subsidy application.

The approved Y2i subsidy from 2023 will transfer to 2024, although it will be pro-rata to the program length. We will also assume those that chose not to take a subsidy or only part thereof, will do the same again this year. Partial subsidy uptakes will be pro-rata to what they elected.

If anyone would like to have their subsidy application reviewed or would like to change the amount of subsidy they require, they can contact us directly.

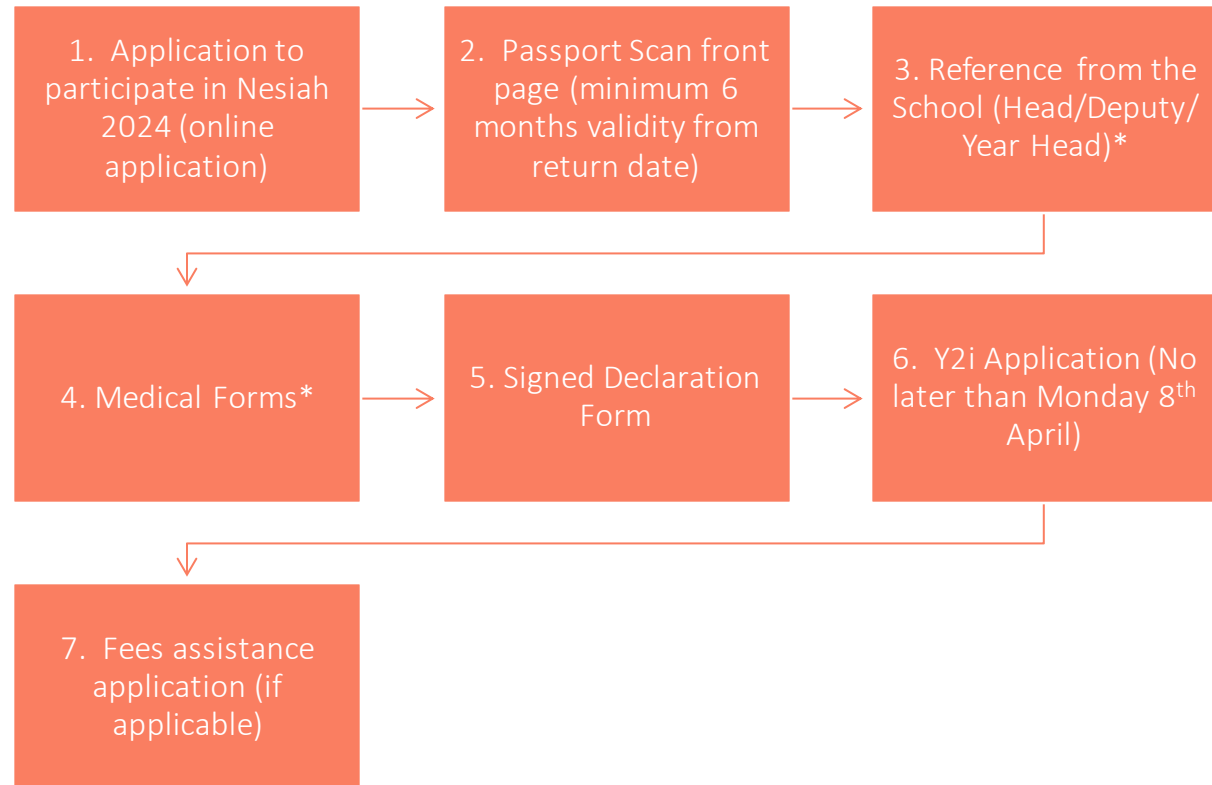
